

SWEET ADELINES INTERNATIONAL INTERNATIONAL BOARD OF DIRECTORS 303RD (MIDYEAR) MEETING

INTERNATIONAL UPDATE

Prior to the October 28-29, 2023 meeting of the International Board of Directors, in Louisville, Kentucky, USA, the Board and senior staff participated in a day and a half, facilitator led, strategic visioning session. The results of the session will be developed by staff into an operational action plan, which will be reviewed by the Board at their March 2024 meeting.

Following is a summary of the actions taken during the October 28-29, 2023 meeting of the International Board of Directors.

The charter and chapter membership for the following chapter was authorized: • Coachella Acapella Chapter, Region 21, Palm Springs, California, USA

The Board reviewed reports of International committees (a list of committees with personnel is available on the website: About tab, Our Board dropdown – near the bottom of the page).

The Board learned that to date 3,384 songs had been submitted via the Song Assessment Tool with the following results:

Total submissions = 3,384Admissible = 2,794Admissible with note = Admissible with caution = Admissible with lyries change = Inadmissible = In queue to be reviewed =

The Board reviewed reports of Headquarters departments including the organization's current financial status. (Copies of the annual audit reports with financial statements can be found on the website Operations tab. Financial stoppdown.).

The Board reviewed the organization's current financial status and the report of the annual independent audit by Hogan Taylor, CPAs. The auditor's report included that the SA financial statements "present fairly, in all material respects, the financial position of the organization as of April 30, 2023 and 2022, and the changes in its net assets and its cash flows for the years then ended in accordance with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America." (*Copies of the yearly undit reports with financial statements can be found on the website Operations tab. Financials dropdown.*)

The Board reviewed the status of registration numbers, hotel contracts, etc. for the International Convention in Louisville, KY, USA in October/November 2023. The Board learned that attendance for the Louisville Convention exceeded that of the 2022 International Convention in Phoenix.

The Board learned that the Ignite the Sound Membership Growth Initiative Volume 2 had resulted in 489 members as of September 29, 2023. Feedback regarding the "Meet the President" online sessions for those new members was positive. Ignite the Sound Volume 2 will offer resources for quartets, choruses and regions, such as social media strategy, participating in your local community, how to recruit alumni, and more. As with Ignite the Sound Volume 1, quartets and choruses may participate in micro contests throughout the year. The Board learned of a collaboration between the Membership Retention Committee and Regional Leadership Committee to provide training, information and networking for Regional Membership Coordinators to assist their chapters in retaining members and maintaining a healthy and happy culture.

The Board learned that the Education Direction Committee had formed a new Youth Outreach Program Task Force to research and recommend a revised youth outreach tool.

The Board learned of staff achievements in moving the organizational mission and vision forward in the areas of membership, finance, philanthropy, International convention & competition, education and marketing. The Board also learned of initiatives developed, deployed or concluded by staff from the Strategic Business Action Plan.

The Board learned of a successful visit by the International President, LoveNotes Quartet, and other representatives to Sweet Adelines choruses and prospective Choruses in Tokyo, Japan. The visits were both educational and developmental, and further supported the efforts to grow the Sweet Adelines presence in Japan.

The Board received education on philanthropy, the reasons donors make charitable gifts, strategies employed to promote giving to support the education programs aligned with donor personal interests, the history of contributions to SA 2017 to present, and the funds to which contributions can be made. Funds are used to support scholarships, grants, and other educational programs geared toward youth, general member education, a new online learning platform, chorus director, judge and arranger training, and more.
